SIS HAS BEEN AWARDED THE CONSTRUCTION AND P3 OF THE TURIN HEALTH COMPLEX IN ITALY

- SIS, a consortium comprising Fininc and Sacyr, will build and manage this project for 25 years, which will require an investment of €517 million.
- The complex will have a hospital with 1,040 beds, a university campus of 5,000 sqm and 1,500 sqm of commercial areas.
- This is Sacyr's third P3 project award in 2024 and strengthens its position in the strategic Italian market.

Turin, October 2, 2024.- SIS consortium (Fininc and Sacyr) has won the P3 project award for the Parco della Salute, della Ricerca e dell'Innovazione di Torino (Turin's Health, Research and Innovation Complex), a multifunctional complex that will include a new hospital and university campus. The contract will be formalized and signed in the coming months. The planned investment exceeds €517 million and the construction period is five years.

This contract, awarded by Azienda Ospedaliera Universitaria Città della Salute e della Scienza di Torino, a Piedmont Region government institution, includes the design, construction, financing, concession and maintenance of the hospital for 25 years. The scope of this P3 contract covers the maintenance of the structural and architectural elements, the mechanical and electrical installations and the management of the commercial areas.

A benchmark facility

This project will become a **medical and scientific reference center in Italy** and its strategic location in the south of Turin will serve around 300,000 people.

The new complex will have **four interconnected blocks**, that will house the current health facilities making up the City of Health: La Molinette, the CTO and the Sant'Anna Hospital. It will host clinical, preclinical and translational research; in addition to offering a space for teaching activities (degree courses in medicine and other health professions).

The main characteristics of the construction of the project are:

- 1,040 beds
- 19 operating rooms
- 175,000 sqm of hospital surface + 64,000 sqm of underground parking
- 5,000 sqm of training areas
- 1,525 sgm of commercial areas

Third P3 project in 2024

This award is the third P3 contract award won by Sacyr this year, after Lima's Peripheral Ring Road (Peru) and Chile's Northern Airport Network; in line with the company's strategic goal.

Italy is a priority market for Sacyr, where, through the **SIS consortium, the company** has the P3 contracts for the Pedemontana-Veneta motorway, the A-3 Naples-Pompeii-Salerno, the A-21 Turin-Piacenza, the A-5 Turin-Quincinetto, the A-5/A-4 connection and the Turin Tangential system and the Via del Mare A4 Jesolo connection.

The company currently manages €22 Bn of investment under management. Sacyr's strategic ambition for 2033 is to become a world leader in the development of transportation, social and water infrastructures.
